How does it work? A proprietary technology developed by Litle & Co., Litle PayPage removes sensitive card data from online orders before they are submitted to merchants. Card number information collected at the checkout page from the shopper's web browser is sent directly to the Litle PayPage application server. Litle tokenizes the sensitive data and returns a PayPage Registration Id back to the web browser. When a cardholder submits the order, the merchant receives all information related to the order, with the card number replaced by a PayPage Registration Id.

Where will my checkout page be hosted? With the Litle PayPage solution, the checkout page is hosted by you. As a result, you retain total control over the branding of your payment page. You can implement any desired changes to your checkout processes while continuing to own and manage your websites.

I am already using Litle Vault for tokenization; why do I need Litle Pay Page? Merchants that accept orders online are exposed to the sensitive card data for a short period of time before they complete registration with the Litle Vault. Litle PayPage provides a solution to this exposure by tokenizing the card number before the order is submitted by the shopper.

Extending the benefits of tokenization technology provided with Litle Vault, Litle PayPage helps merchants to reduce their scope of PCI compliance even further. With the Litle PayPage solution, merchants will avoid any exposure to sensitive card data received through online channels during the order acceptance process.

How Litle & Co. Can Help

Litle PayPage enables you to safely remove sensitive cardholder data from your customer's order before it ever hits your system. Here's how:

Tokenizes Sensitive Card Data The cardholder's browser interacts with the Litle PayPage server to tokenize the card prior to the submission of the cardholder order to the merchant.

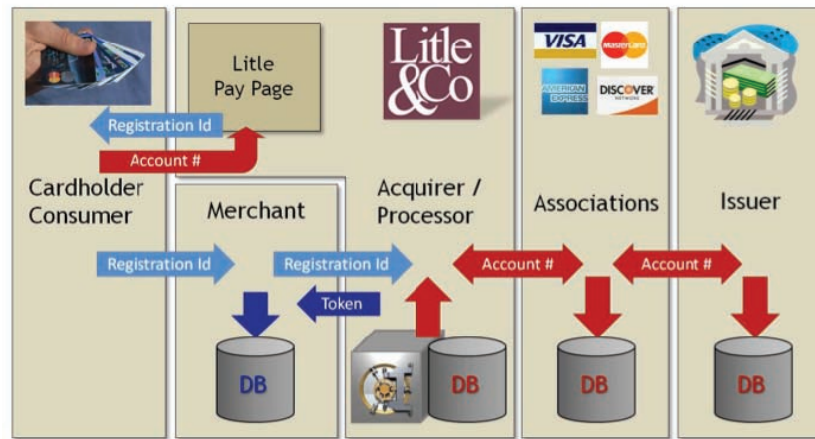
Eliminates Exposure, Limits Merchant Liability Using Litle PayPage, merchants avoid any significant exposure to sensitive card data for orders received through online channels. Restricted access to card data may help merchants limit their liability and reduce their data security related insurance costs.

Reduces scope of PCI Compliance Litle PayPage may significantly reduce PCI scope by reducing visibility into sensitive cardholder data during order acceptance. PCI scope reduction depends on the number of internal touch points a card has within your operations such as marketing, accounting and customer support.

Enables Transparent Tokenization of Existing Customer Accounts or e-Wallets In addition to its application at the payment stage, Litle PayPage can also be utilized for tokenizing customers' payment options in electronic wallets. The stored card information is tokenized without you touching it. This approach can speed up the checkout process and can also increase the number of completed sales.

It's Your Website — Own and Control It Unique among similar offerings, Litle PayPage does not host, clone or replicate your website content. You remain the checkout page host. You can implement any desired changes to your website without having to notify us first. You maintain total ownership and control over the look, feel and content of your web presence.
